## Scope and Aim

The 3<sup>rd</sup> HLCA Summer School focusses on health literacy research, including critical perspectives from childhood studies. Aiming at interactive working, it will provide both a general and a specific overview on theoretical and practical evidence regarding health literacy.

Participants will be introduced into:

- conceptual and methodological considerations,
- the use of measurement methods and data analysis,
- methods and ethics of childhood research,
- intervention studies,
- health literacy policy-making and social issues,
- gender studies,
- advocacy for health literacy and health literacy champions, including skill development.

## Format

### Lectures, Teachings and Presentations

Key experts from health promotion, health literacy, childhood research, education, and health equity will teach and give keynote presentations on the newest developments in the field.

### Working Groups

Besides teaching, participants will collaboratively work in different working groups addressing research development and designing own projects as well as health literacy action plans and policy proposals.

### Market Place

Participants will introduce their findings and project ideas at the market place. This will allow for reflecting and critically discussing their approaches.

### Presentation / Jury

The Summer School will be complemented with the presentation of the results of the interactive sessions.
